Travelling to Bochum via train - Pay attention to route closures!

Due to constructional measures at Bochum main station (**Bochum Hbf**), many long-distance and local trains will not stop at Bochum main station currently. Depending on your route, you can take the following connections instead:

- From Gelsenkirchen Main Station (Gelsenkirchen Hbf), take the local train RE1 or RE6 to Herne main station (Herne Hbf). From there, you can take the subway U35 in the direction Bochum Hustadt and exit at the stop Ruhr-Universität or at Bochum Hbf.
- From Herne Wanne-Eickel main station (Wanne-Eickel Hbf), take local train RE3 (direction Hamm Westf Hbf) or S2 (direction Dortmund Hbf) to Herne main station (Herne Hbf) – it takes only one stop. From there, you can take the subway U35 in the direction Bochum Hustadt and exit at the stop Ruhr-Universität or at Bochum Hbf.
- From Dortmund main station (**Dortmund Hbf**), take the train S1 in direction Solingen Hbf to reach **Bochum Hbf**.
- From Essen main station (Essen Hbf), take the train S1 in direction Dortmund Hbf to reach Bochum Hbf.



Travelling from Bochum Hbf to the University (and back)

From Bochum main station you can easily take the **U35 subway** (Campus line) to the Ruhr University, which has its own stop.

The U35 (towards Bochum Hustadt) runs every 5 minutes on weekdays and takes less than 10 minutes from the main train station to the University.







Your way from U35 station to the convention center



Leave the subway U35 at station **Ruhr-Universität**


Walk up the stairs and turn right.



Cross the bridge and head towards the library.



In front of the library turn left and walk down the stairs to the plaza



Enter the refectory building. Inside the building turn left. At the end of the corridor is an elevator that takes you to floor 04 (**Veranstaltungszentrum**)



Pass the Auditorium Maximum on the left side.

Bochum's probably oldest surviving residential and inn. The Old Rietkötter Brewing House is one of the oldest houses in Bochum, dating from 1630. Originally a private home, it became a brewery in 1777.

The inn can be easily reached on foot from Bochum main train station (Bochum Hbf).

The next stop on the U35 subway is Bochum Rathaus (Nord).

Drivers can park nearby in the P5 or PH Massenbergstrasse car park or look for a parking space on the Ostring.
